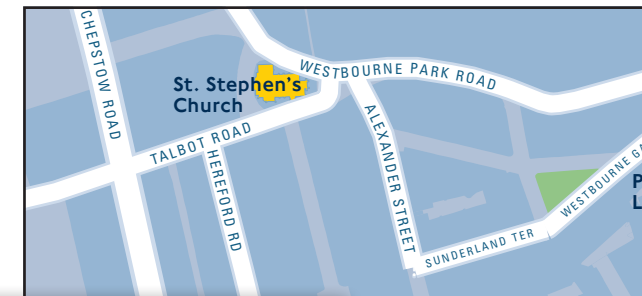

Bakerloo line trains will not stop at Paddington station
2 April until mid-August



IMPROVEMENTS UNDER WAY

What's happening from Saturday 2 April until mid-August?

The Bakerloo line will not stop at Paddington station. This is while we renew both escalators to allow them to run for a further 20 years.

We will also be constructing a new walkway between the Bakerloo and Elizabeth line platforms, which will open once Elizabeth line services run from the new station in December 2018.

Alternative travel advice from Paddington

For central London, please use one of the following routes:

Circle line
Hammersmith & City line From platform 16 to Baker Street and change for alternative Tube routes

District line To Notting Hill Gate and change for the Central line, or change at Earl's Court for alternative Tube routes

Circle line via Victoria and Embankment

For the Bakerloo line

There are signed walking routes to Edgware Road and Warwick Avenue Tube stations (see map overleaf). Alternatively, use any bus from stop H on Praed Street.

✈ Going to Heathrow?
