Information for referrers

Service offered

We offer a specialist psychiatrist assessment which takes into account the biopsychosocial aspects of the person's presentation.

We aim to provide a written formulation to help the person and their healthcare professionals make use of the available management options available.

This may be assessment only or a short term work to move the person along their journey.

Referral criteria

Patient has H and F or Chiswick GP

Patient has a diagnosis of diabetes type 1 or 2

There is evidence of mental health issues but mental health diagnosis may be unclear

The patient is not currently under secondary mental health services
