## Your hospital health records

You and your parents can have access to your hospital records though the Care Information Exchange.

You can see your test results, hospital appointments and doctor's letters. You can also enter your own information such as symptoms you are experiencing and medication you are taking to provide a more complete record of your care.

It's your choice if you want you and your parents to be able to see your records.

## How do I register?

Complete the registration form and provide proof of identity. You will need an email address for your username and so we can tell you when new information is added to your record. Your parents will also need to register if you would like them have access.
