Who we are/what we do

- Integrated team of Specialist Continence Nurses & Women's Health Physiotherapists with support of Gynaecologists, Urologists and Uro-gynaecologists
- Assess & treat men & women with bladder/bowel dysfunction who have GPs in Central London CCG (Westminster)
- Often can prevent unnecessary referrals to secondary care (NICE 2012)

Commonly treated conditions

- Stress urinary incontinence
- Urge urinary Incontinence
- Post natal pelvic floor dysfunction
- Pelvic organ prolapse (above the level of the introitus)
- Voiding dysfunction
- Detrusor Overactivity
- Constipation
- Faecal incontinence
- Dyspareunia
- Chronic Pelvic pain
- Recurrent urinary tract infections & Cystitis
- Catheter care/Trial without catheters
- Post prostatectomy
- Post chemotherapy and radiotherapy

First Line management (1)

Investigations will include:

- History Taking
- Medical
- Obstetric
- Surgical
- Medication
- Pelvic Floor muscle assessment
- Perianal area assessment
- Digital rectal examination
- Bladder Scan
- Urinalysis
- Uroflowmetry

First line management (2)

Treatments include:

- pelvic floor muscle rehabilitation,
- bladder retraining,
- electrical stimulation,
- neuromodulation,
- biofeedback,
- acupuncture,
- lifestyle advice
- containment products & many more.

Accessing The Service

- All referrals are triaged by a senior clinician to either physiotherapy or nursing.
- Our referral form has been designed to help with the accuracy of triage.
- Patients are seen within 28 days of receiving referral.
- Initial appointments are 60 minutes, follow ups 15-30 minutes.
- Patients with complex needs can be cross referred to specialities such as Urology & Urogynaecology within our team (without requiring another referral)
- Patients must be mobile enough to attend clinic
- For housebound patients our nurses can provide support and advice to the district and community nurses where necessary.
- Point of contact Imperial (SMH currently) but clinics operate out of multiple venues across Westminster CCG

Referral Process

- Referrals accepted from all health care professionals
- Potential for self referral in the future
- Referral forms are not currently available on our Website (work in progress) However they should be on system One
- Referral forms can be requested via email (see contact details)
- Letter of referral detailing patients symptoms/reason for referral, PMH, social needs (interpreter/carer present etc) will also be accepted.
