## Introduction

From time to time many of us experience sexual difficulties. If you have such problems, the Jane Wadsworth (sexual function) clinic may be able to help you.

The clinic is part of the Jefferiss wing at St Mary's Hospital in Paddington, an internationally-acknowledged centre of excellence for the treatment of sexual health problems. We specialise in treating sexual function problems for both individuals and couples. These include:

### In men:

- erectile difficulties
- rapid ejaculation
- delayed ejaculation
- loss of sexual desire

### In women:

- sexual desire and arousal difficulties
- orgasmic difficulties
- painful or difficult intercourse

## Our team

The clinic is run by Dr David Goldmeier, a well-known researcher and world authority on sexual function problems. Dr Goldmeier leads a team of experts who specialise in treating men and women experiencing sexual difficulties.

This team includes physicians, psychologists, sexual therapists, a physiotherapist and senior nurses.

## How can I make an appointment?

You must be referred to the Jefferiss wing sexual function service by your GP via the NHS e-Referral service. Please ask your GP to do this.

## Your appointment at the Jane Wadsworth clinic

At your first appointment we will listen to you and start to assess the difficulties you are experiencing. Tests and treatment will be arranged as needed.

Follow up may be with the same clinician or another member of the team, for example, a sex therapist, psychologist or physiotherapist. It may include further assessment, examination, assessing response to treatment and on-going help.

You will be discharged back to your GP when this is deemed appropriate by your clinician.
