







Easy read information for patients, relatives and carers coming into hospital

	<p>Who can visit our hospitals during Covid?</p>
	<p>Family and friends of a person who is dying.</p>
	<p>A carer of a person with extra needs: learning disabilities, autism or dementia.</p>
	<p>A parent of a child.</p>
	<p>A birth partner.</p>
	<p>Speak to the ward sister about visiting rules and Carer's passport.</p>

	<p>Covid safety rules apply in hospital:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Wash hands</li> <li>• Cover face</li> <li>• Leave space (social distance 2 metres if possible)</li> </ul>
	<p>Do not come to hospital if you feel unwell:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Headache</li> <li>• Sore throat</li> <li>• Cough</li> </ul>
	<p>You must wear a face mask in hospital.</p>
	<p>Use hand gel or wash your hands when entering and leaving a ward or unit.</p>
	<p>Wear the same type of PPE as staff on the ward. Speak to staff, they will help you.</p>
