




Changes to the GP pathology system – improving HF referrals

Features / functions

- 7. Guidance for GPs to refer to the specialist heart failure services, directly from the blood test / pathology results that GPs can access via the EHR. It is hoped that this will increase the number of patients being referred
- 8. Shortness of Breath panel has added NT-pro BNP test option to increase opportunities for GPs to request them



HFSN templates required a redesign from their current format

The previous HFSN templates were cumbersome with too many tabs and information which were not efficiently designed / organised. HFSNs had to repeatedly manually enter information into the patient record and also the patient letters. With the new GP HF template, it was important to mirror the same codes and features of that template into the new HFSN template design.

- 4. Pop-outs for Investigations & Devices and RPM
- 5. RPM patient status, onboarding, offboarding





- 3. Patient goals and actions included here for automatic extraction into the letters
- 4. QOL questionnaire scoring for recording in S1
- 5. Medication notes that the HFSNs can easily provide into a free text box



The new HFSN Heart Failure template – key features

Features / functions

- 1. Easier, direct referrals via S1 instead of using letters to refer to community
- 2. Letters are featured in one place, on this tab
- 3. Data is automatically extracted into letters



Other key features and benefits of the new HFSN templates

- With new functionality programmed into the new templates, HFSNs will now be able to save the data upon completing a consultation record for each patient. This means they no longer have to copy and paste information back into the record nor manually input it again. HFSNs can reopen each patient profile and view what was recorded previously
- Blood test data can now be viewed easily on the Diagnosis tab which means HFSNs no longer need to access ICE to then copy and paste the details into S1
- Letters are easily and automatically generated by pulling in all of the information from the template HFSNs can create letters efficiently without having to copy and paste information and they are able to add in any edits if they wish
